

INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

at the National Center for Nuclear Research

for contractors and partners, their representatives, attorneys, representatives, employees, associates in connection with the conclusion and implementation of a contract or agreement or project

According to Art. 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27. 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

- 1. The Controller of your personal data is the National Center for Nuclear Research (hereinafter referred to as NCBJ) with its registered office in Otwock, Andrzeja Sołtana 7, 05-400 Otwock.
- 2. You may contact the Data Protection Officer at NCBJ at the address given above or at the address iod@ncbj.gov.pl.
- 3. The personal data Controller processes your personal data on the basis of applicable law and in connection with the implementation of the contract/agreement.

- 5. In connection with the processing of personal data for the purposes referred to in point 4, your personal data may be transferred to entities supporting the internal activities of NCBJ (e.g. law firms, tax offices, auditors, suppliers of systems and solutions, payment service providers), entities authorized under the provisions laws. In addition, the recipients of personal data may be other entities and persons, which, on the basis of relevant agreements signed with NCBJ, process personal data, for which the NCBJ is the Controller, or for which NCBJ is obliged to demonstrate the accountability of the project/contract/agreement.
- 6. Your personal data will be stored for the period indicated in the contract/agreement/project binding the parties, for the period of required archiving, as well as for the period specified in the contract and/or for the period for pursuing possible claims.
- 7. In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights: the right to access personal data and receive a copy thereof, the right to request rectification or supplementation of personal data, the right to request removal of personal data (the so-called right to be forgotten), unless deletion of personal data is not possible pursuant to Art. 17 sec. 3 b), d) or e) of the GDPR and the right to request the restriction of personal data processing.
- 8. If you become aware of the unlawful processing of your personal data at NCBJ, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority competent in matters of personal data protection.
- 9. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organizations.
- 10. You will not be subject to automated decision making or profiling.
- We receive your personal data from you either directly or from the entity with which the 11. aforementioned contract/agreement has been concluded or the project is being implemented, and you have been indicated therein as a contractor, partner, representative, agent, employee or
- 12. The processing of your personal data by NCBJ includes personal data necessary to perform the contract, i.e.: name, surname, business address for contact, e-mail, telephone number, as well as personal data necessary to enable access to the NCBJ premises, i.e.: identity document number and foreigner's citizenship, vehicle registration number, image, contents of parcels and parcels brought in/left from the NCBJ premises.
