

## INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

at the National Center for Nuclear Research for press accreditation

According to Art. 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27. 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

- 1. The Controller of your personal data is the National Center for Nuclear Research (hereinafter referred to as NCBJ) with its registered office in Otwock, Andrzeja Sołtana 7, 05-400 Otwock.
- 2. You may contact the Data Protection Officer at NCBJ at the address given above or at the address iod@ncbj.gov.pl.
- 3. The personal data Controller processes your personal data on the basis of applicable law and for the purposes specified below.
- 4. Your personal data is processed for the purpose of:

5. In connection with the processing of personal data for the purposes referred to in point 4, your





- personal data may be transferred to entities supporting the internal activities of NCBJ (e.g. law firms, tax offices, auditors, suppliers of systems and solutions), primarily to entities authorized under the provisions laws.
- 6. Your personal data will be stored for the period of required archiving, as well as for the period for pursuing possible claims.
- 7. In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights: the right to access personal data and receive a copy thereof, the right to request rectification or supplementation of personal data, the right to request removal of personal data (the so-called right to be forgotten), unless deletion of personal data is not possible pursuant to Art. 17 sec. 3 b), d) or e) of the GDPR and the right to request the restriction of personal data processing.
- 8. If you become aware of the unlawful processing of your personal data at NCBJ, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority competent in matters of personal data protection.
- 9. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organizations.
- 10. You will not be subject to automated decision making or profiling.
- 11. We receive your personal data from you either directly or from your employer/entity that you represent or on behalf of which you have applied for accreditation.
- 12. The processing of your personal data by NCBJ includes personal data providing during the accreditation process, i.e.: name and surname, e-mail, phone number, press card number, name and address of the editorial office, as well as personal data necessary to enable access to the NCBJ premises, i.e.: identity document number and foreigner's citizenship, brand name and device number of equipment brought onto the premises of the NCBJ.
