

INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

at the National Center for Nuclear Research

regarding the control of access to the NCBJ premises and the image captured by video monitoring

According to Art. 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27. 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (GDPR), we would like to inform you that:

- 1. The Controller of your personal data is the National Center for Nuclear Research (hereinafter referred to as NCBJ) with its registered office in Otwock, Andrzeja Sołtana 7, 05-400 Otwock.
- 2. You may contact the Data Protection Officer at NCBJ at the address given above or at the address iod@ncbj.gov.pl.
- 3. The personal data Controller processes your personal data on the basis of applicable law, including the Act of August 22, 1997 on the protection of persons and property and other security regulations. Providing personal data is mandatory.
- 4. Your personal data is processed for the purpose of:

- 5. Documentation regarding passes and recordings from video surveillance may be made available to entities authorized under the law, i.e. law enforcement authorities.
- 6. Your personal data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the objectives set out in point 4 and in accordance with applicable law.
- 7. In connection with the processing of your personal data, you have the following rights:
 - 1) the right to access personal data and receive a copy thereof,
 - 2) the right to request rectification of personal data,
 - 3) the right to request restriction of personal data processing,
 - 4) the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw.
- 8. Your personal data will not be transferred to third countries or international organizations.
- 9. You will not be subject to automated decision making, including profiling.
- 10. If you entered/entered the NCBJ premises in connection with your:
 - 1) employment or a visit to the Radioactive Waste Management Plant or at other entities residing on the premises of NCBJ,
 - 2) visit as a contractor or external contractor performing commissioned work
 - 3) visit as an individual guest or an organized group
 - we receive your personal data from entities informing NCBJ about the need to enter/enter the NCBJ premises.
- 11. The processing of your personal data by NCBJ includes personal data necessary to issue a pass and enable entry/exit to the NCBJ premises, i.e.: name, surname, citizenship, identity document, delegating institution, purpose of the visit, date and time of the visit, address, vehicle, registration number, image, contents of parcels and packages brought in/out of the NCBJ premises.
